

# Haber

## Used as an Auxiliary Verb

The auxiliary (helping) verb "haber" helps us talk about completed actions, events, etc. in the past, present and future.

Indicative Mood Compound Tenses		yo	tú	usted/ él/ella	nosotros/ nosotras	ustedes/ ellos/ellas
<i>present</i>	<i>have</i>	he	has	ha	hemos	han
<i>imperfect</i>	<i>had</i>	había	habías	había	habíamos	habían
<i>future</i>	<i>will have</i>	habré	habrás	habrá	habremos	habrán
<i>conditional</i>	<i>would have</i>	habría	habrías	habría	habríamos	habrían

  

Subjunctive Mood Compound Tenses		yo	tú	usted/ él/ella	nosotros/ nosotras	ustedes/ ellos/ellas
<i>present</i>	<i>have</i>	haya	hayas	haya	hayamos	hayan
<i>imperfect</i>	<i>had</i>	hubiera	hubieras	hubiera	hubiéramos	hubieran

### Examples of "Haber" in other forms:

<b>Infinitive</b>	<b>haber</b>	<i>I should have eaten.</i>	<b>Yo debería haber comido.</b>
<b>Gerund</b>	<b>habiendo</b>	<i>Having already paid, I left.</i>	<b>Habiendo pagado ya, me fui.</b>
<b>Participle</b>	<b>habido</b>	<i>There has been an accident.</i>	<b>Ha habido un accidente.</b>

### Examples of "Haber" as an auxiliary verb:

<i>I have visited many countries.</i>	<b>He visitado muchos países.</b>
<i>They have done an excellent job.</i>	<b>Han hecho un excelente trabajo.</b>
<i>Have you finished the task?</i>	<b>¿Has terminado la tarea?</b>

### Examples of "Haber" as an impersonal verb:

<i>There are two dishes on the table.</i>	<b>Hay dos platos en la mesa.</b>
<i>There was an explosion at the mine.</i>	<b>Hubo una explosión en la mina.</b>
<i>There will be a party tomorrow.</i>	<b>Habrà una fiesta mañana.</b>

## Used as an Impersonal Verb

Impersonal verbs don't have subjects and therefore do not conjugate for each pronoun.

Indicative Mood	Simple Tenses	
<i>present</i>	<i>there is/are</i>	<b>hay</b>
<i>preterite</i>	<i>there was/were</i>	<b>hubo</b>
<i>imperfect</i>	<i>there was/were</i>	<b>había</b>
<i>future</i>	<i>there will be</i>	<b>habrá</b>
<i>conditional</i>	<i>there would be</i>	<b>habría</b>

  

Indicative Mood (perfect)	Compound Tenses	
<i>present</i>	<i>there has been</i>	<b>ha habido</b>
<i>future</i>	<i>there will have been</i>	<b>habrá habido</b>
<i>conditional</i>	<i>there would have been</i>	<b>habría habido</b>

  

Subjunctive Mood	Simple Tenses	
<i>present</i>	<i>there is/are</i>	<b>haya</b>
<i>imperfect</i>	<i>there was/were</i>	<b>hubiera/hubiese</b>

  

Subjunctive Mood	Compound Tenses	
<i>present perfect</i>	<i>there has been</i>	<b>haya habido</b>
<i>pluperfect</i>	<i>there had been</i>	<b>hubiera/hubiese habido</b>
